They live busy and rewarding lives, sharing a love for singing and performing as part of a community choir and theatre arts group. With the love and support of their families and the L'Arche community they are preparing to spread their wings and live independently. The community's next challenge is to build up sufficient funds to employ a live-in Community leader while WA awaits the rollout of the NDIS.

40 year Anniversary




L'Arche Australia Ltd Financial Summary In 2016-17 our income was \$395,000.
